French surrealist artist **Pierre Molinier** produced photographs which were erotic self-portraits, often using himself as a model for the 'divine hermaphrodite'. Taken between 1965 and 1976, the year of his suicide, these images were never exhibited during his lifetime. Now on view for the first time in Australia, this exhibition establishes Molinier as a major precursor to Robert Mapplethorpe.
