***WHO'S AFRAID OF PUBLIC SPACE?* READING SPACE PUBLIC BOOKINGS**

Before your visit, please familiarise yourself with ACCA's [Visit](#) page which includes more information on COVID-Safe and Access requirements, and how to get to ACCA.

1. All visitors to ACCA must follow current state government health guidelines. Visitors aged 18 years and over must have received both doses of a COVID-19 vaccine and will be asked to provide proof of vaccination upon entry and check in via the Services Victoria App.
2. The use of ACCA spaces is permitted only on the times listed in your booking.
3. The applicant must notify info@acca.melbourne if there are any changes to the booking.
4. ACCA reserves the right to refuse the booking if it compromises ACCA's integrity in any way and the safety and security of the building.
5. The applicant is responsible for the behaviour of their guests and must ensure that all visitors and ACCA staff are treated respectfully. ACCA will not be responsible for any misconduct or anti-social behaviour. ACCA reserves the right to end the booking.
6. Food and drink are not permitted in the space.
7. Applications are welcome from those under the age of 18, but a supervisor or support person who is aged over 18 must be in attendance and be noted on the application.
